



WASTE SEPARATION:

"THE USE OF COLOR CODES"

Short description:

The Iberhotel Dahabeya at Dahab, Egypt, is separating waste systematically by using color codes.

To avoid waste is the primary goal. However, a hotel produces a lot of garbage. To ensure that the waste can be reused or recycled later, it is important to separate it. An optimal solution is the separation by color codes. Here, different colors signify different materials. This system allows staff and guests to separate waste easily from the dustbins up to the final stage in the garbage room.
